## "Big Bill" France Statue

The "Big Bill" France and Anne France statue is a commemorative statue to remember founder of NASCAR and his hardworking wife. "Big Bill" France is known as the founder of the worlds largest stock car racing organization while his wife was helped him reach his goals. Anne was secretary and treasurer of NASCAR when Daytona International Speedway opened in 1959. This statue is located in Daytona Beach, Florida



## Miles The Monster

Miles the monster is probably the most popular track mascot in NASCAR. Miles is the track mascot for Dover International Speedway located in Delaware. The name originates from the track's nickname "The Monster Mile" the grueling mile long short track. Miles the Monster is a 46-foot tall fiber-glass statue and one of the biggest in the United States. Miles is also equipped with a full size stock-car that is placed in his hand by a crane.

## Dale Earnhardt Statues

February, 18, 2001 NASCAR lost a legend and debatably one of the greatest drivers of all time: Dale Earnhardt Sr. Dale died of a basilar skull fracture that occurred after impact into the wall on the last lap of the 2001 Daytona 500. These two statues located at the Daytona International Speedway and Kannapolis North Carolina (Hometown) are in memory of the seven-time champion

## Streamline Hotel

The Streamline Hotel is a landmark that many NASCAR fans don't know about. The Streamline Hotel is located in Daytona Beach Florida and is the true birthplace of NASCAR. Bill France brought together a group of racers at the Streamline Hotel and discussed the idea of creating a sanctioning body. This three-day meeting ended with the formation of the National Association of Stock Car Auto Racing.
