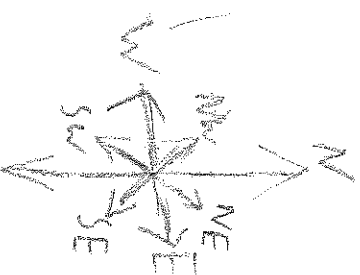

Mojave Map Explanation

This map is what I believe would be created by some wanderer in the Mojave Wasteland, because the map you get in game, the digital one on your Pip Boy, is too perfect and it's not like everyone has a pip boy. It was pure chance that your player character is given one. So, I designed a more rough and imperfect map like one that would've been hand made. It includes markers to point out potentially (or absolutely) dangerous areas, settlements/areas to trade supplies, places to seek medical attention, and faction-controlled areas in case you would need to avoid certain factions. There is also a couple little smaller details marked down as well

- there are some doodles pertaining to the areas they are around
- the little dinosaur by Novac is because of Dinky the Dinosaur, the giant Dinosaur statue in front of the motel
- Jacobstown and Black Mountain are the only two main places you'll find groups of Super Mutants in the Mojave, and the ones at Jacobstown are peaceful while the ones at Black Mountain are hostile, hence 'Good Muties' and 'Bad Muties'
- There's an erased star beneath the Legion bull marker at Nipton, this is intentional as Nipton was an independent town but then the Legion invaded it and slaughtered everyone
- The question marks around Hidden Valley are because the person who created the map would likely not now that the reason it's dangerous at night is because of the Brotherhood of Steel presence in the bunkers of the valley and their need to remain hidden
- the grave drawn by Bitter Springs is in reference to the Bitter Springs Massacre, which was perpetrated by the NCR against the Great Khans

A little fun fact is that Cazadore Canyon just north of Goodsprings is not the official name of the place. It makes sense, as it's a canyon that's filled with the dangerous giant mutated Tarantula Hawks that Cazadore's are, but upon searching it up, I found nothing about it although I swear I've heard someone call it Cazadore Canyon. But officially, it's just the nameless, dangerous shortcut to The Strip that's at the start of the game.

I left the good copy of my map in pencil, as it feels more in character for a map in a wasteland to be done in pencil (or something pencil-like, like charcoal or something) rather than neatly in pen. I hope this is okay. Otherwise I dunno, deduct the marks or something I guess.
